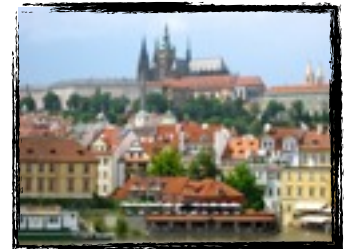

### Itinerary

**June 14<sup>th</sup>:** Depart Australia, travel via Hong Kong and Zurich.

15<sup>th</sup>: Arrive Berlin. Check in - Berlin Motel One in Ku'Damm - and a welcome dinner.

16<sup>th</sup>: Free day.... explore Brandenburg Gate, Unter den Linden Blvd and the Kurfurstendamm. Stroll the Ku'damm, that glossy, store-lined showcase of western capitalism, or Unter den Linden, the Prussian centerpiece of the Berlin-Mitte district. Also check out The **Alexanderplatz**, named for Russian Czar Alexander I, was the center of activity in the old East Berlin. Neon lights and bright murals now coexist alongside the dull and fading GDR-era structures, and street musicians and small markets give the area new life. Other options include Checkpoint Charlie, Fernsehturm as well as many museums and attractions.

17<sup>th</sup>: Free day.

18<sup>th</sup> -20<sup>th</sup>: **Berlin Open**

21<sup>st</sup>: Travel by train to Prague. Arrive and check in at Slavia.

22<sup>nd</sup>: Free Day. Check out Prague Castle, Charles Bridge, the amazing architecture of Old Town etc

23<sup>rd</sup>-25<sup>th</sup>: **Prague Cup**

26<sup>th</sup>: Prague Cup. Finals (to be held in Sytip Arena

27<sup>th</sup>: Free Day. Depart in Evening for Australia (via Zurich and Hong Kong)
